If you arrive by train, it's best to take the south exit. The steps in front of you are the gateway to the city.

From here it's just a stone's throw to the Alter Markt. You certainly won't be bored here – it's the place to be on match day!

It's full of bars and restaurants and the renowned 'Black and Yellow' atmosphere, cold drinks and Currywurst with fries await you here.

Don't miss: Not far away, opposite the Reinoldikirche, is the Curry-Fan, Nobby Dickel's take-away Currywurst stand.

Preparation

Three and half hours to go until kick-off.

The anticipation is tangible – across the whole city! It's time for a little detour to the Kreuzviertel, Dortmund's epicenter of cool. A string of bars and bistros full of Black and Yellow fans awaits you between the two main streets, Lindemannstraße and Hohe Straße. If your provisions are running low, look for the next kiosk, or head into a bar. Cheers!

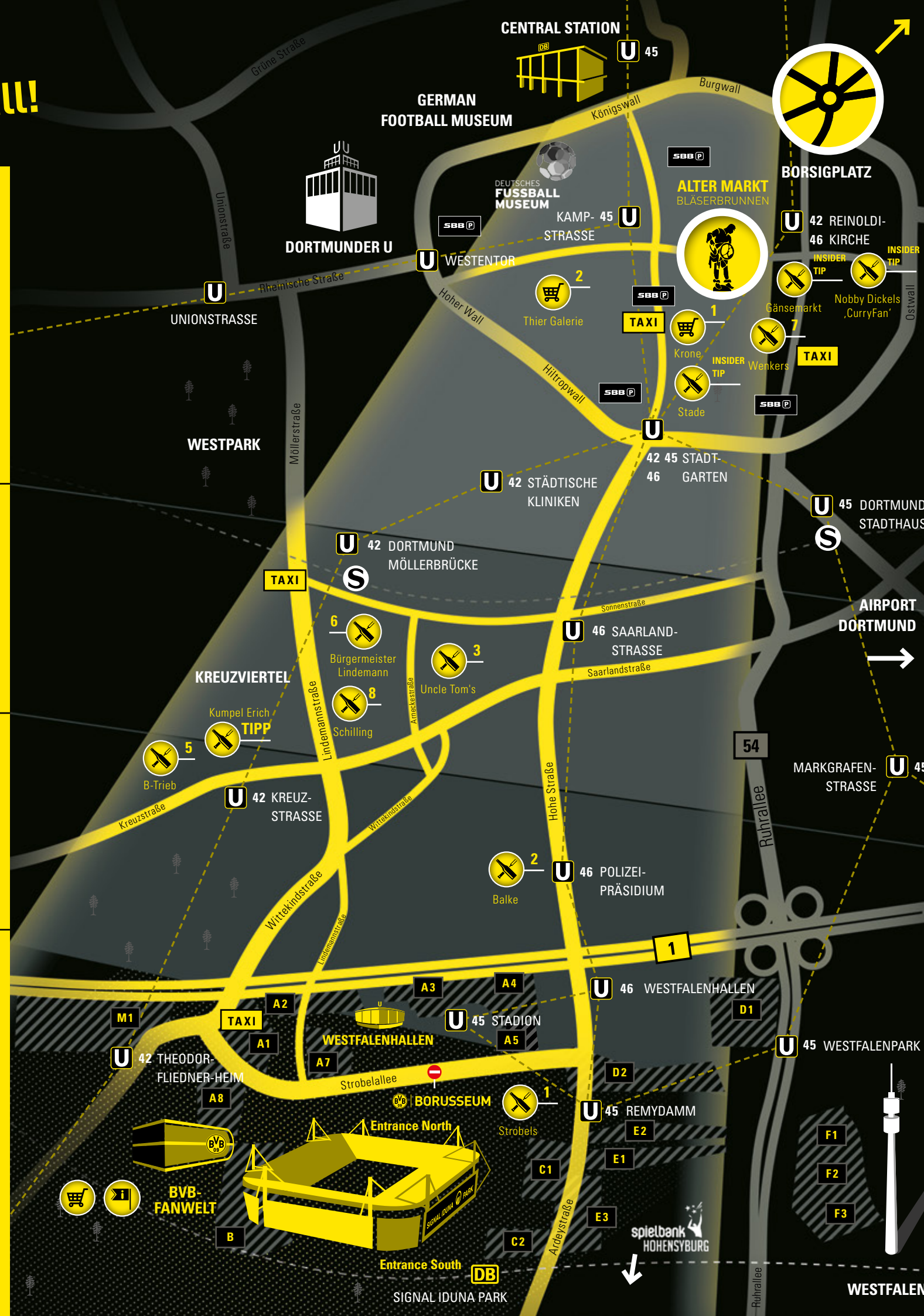

Borsigplatz

Want to visit the birthplace of Borussia Dortmund? Head to Borsigplatz! It was here that our founding fathers laid the foundation for our one-of-a-kind club - Ballspielverein Borussia 09 e.V. Dortmund - in the Zum Wildschütz restaurant. Wir sind alle am Borsigplatz geboren! (We were all born at Borsigplatz!)



Central Station

There are two options: walk through the city or head straight to the stadium! The U45 and the U46 take you directly to the 'temple'. If you have a bit more time on your hands, consider walking to the stadium. Without any stops – although there are some great things to see and do along the way – you can reach the stadium in 30-35 minutes.



Alter Markt (Old Market)

The first place many Black and Yellow fans gather before any home game. There's no lack of pre-game eating and drinking options here, and it's a great place to celebrate a victory as well. From here it takes about 15 minutes to walk to the bars and restaurants of the Kreuzviertel, or you can ride there even quicker by taking the U42 to the Möllerbrücke station.

Information

The gates open 2 ½ hours before kick-off at the SIGNAL IDUNA PARK. A guide to the entrances and stands can be found on the reverse of your ticket.

If you have questions about your tickets or anything else at all, go to one of our two information desks: in the BVB FanWelt (our biggest BVB FanShop - right in front of the stadium) or at the clearing area by the North Entrance to the stadium.

BVB-Stadiondeckel (payment card)

You can pay without cash in the stadium by using a BVB-Stadiondeckel payment card. You can get one in all BVB FanShops, in the BVB FanWelt or from one of our 80 roving promoters in the stadium. The card can be loaded on purchase, via the BVB App or PayPal. After the 60th minute of the game, any credit remaining on your card can be collected from one of the designated payment desks.

BY CAR

There are over 10,000 pay-and-display parking spaces available within a short distance of the SIGNAL IDUNA PARK and Westfalenhallen. Please note: On match days the Strobelallee is closed in both directions.

Additional parking is available at the University of Dortmund, from €2 per car. A shuttle bus departs from the University to the stadium, returning after the end of the game.

BY TRAIN

The main station for fans travelling to the stadium via intercity Deutsche Bahn services is Dortmund Hauptbahnhof (central station). The SIGNAL IDUNA PARK has its own train station served by the following regional trains: RB52, RB53, RB59

BY UNDERGROUND

Extra trains run to the stadium on match days. Furthermore, the **U45** underground train continues to the Stadion station for all home games. The station is located just a few metres from the SIGNAL IDUNA PARK.

You can travel with **(U45)** or with **(U46)** to the Westfalenhallen **(U46)** or Stadion **(U45)** stations. Both are within eyeshot of the SIGNAL IDUNA PARK. You can also get to the stadium with the **U42** line. Alight at the Theodor-Fliehdner Heim station, a 7-minute walk from the stadium.



BUS

The **450** bus line goes to the Westfalenhallen station.

TICKET CENTRE

The Ticket Centre is open Monday to Friday from 10am to 6pm. If there is an evening game during the week (e.g. Wednesday at 8.30pm), then the Ticket Centre is open until the beginning of the match. For games on Saturdays or Sundays, the Ticket Centre opens four hours before the game begins and closes at kick-off.

Located right next the SIGNAL IDUNA PARK and over 2,000 square metres in size, the BVB FanWelt is the largest BVB FanShop. A visit here is a great experience for fans young and old.

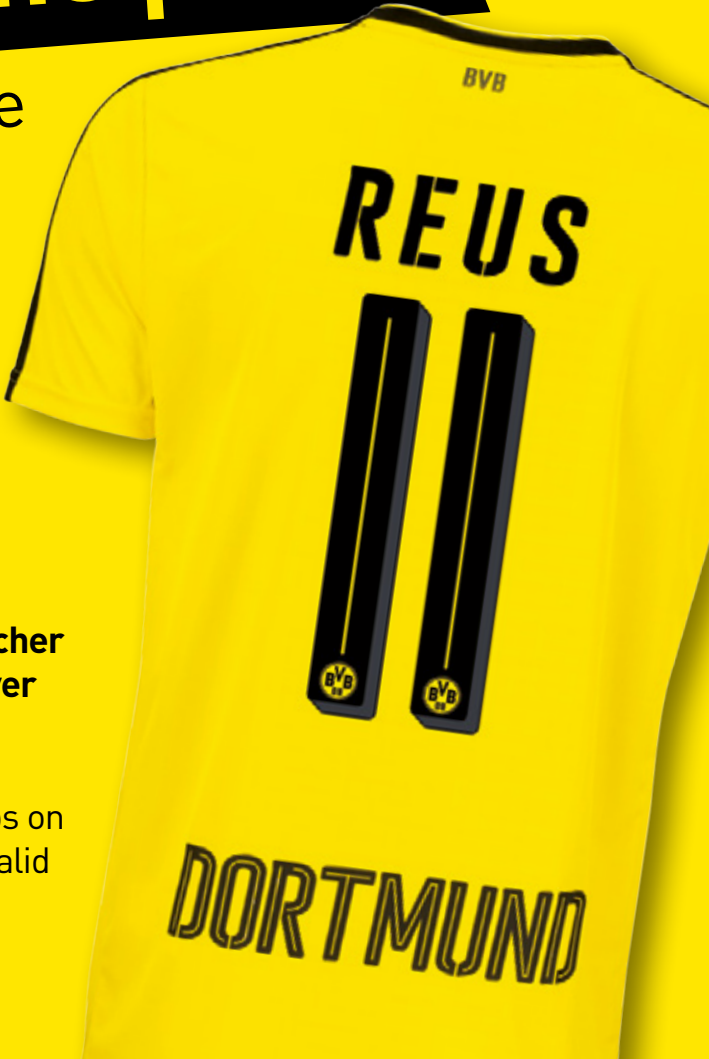
BVB-Matchday Map
